## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

August 21-25, 2006

Here is what you can expect on Aurora Avenue:

- Excavation along the east side of Aurora from N 145<sup>th</sup> to N 152<sup>nd</sup> Streets and from south of N 155<sup>th</sup> to N 160<sup>th</sup> Streets.
- Installation of curb and gutter and driveways along the east side of Aurora from N 155<sup>th</sup> Street to N 165<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Continued construction of the Interurban Trail bridge walls.
- Installation of irrigation along the west side of Aurora.
- Grinding and paving of asphalt on the east side of the Aurora centerline.
- Excavation for the medians between N 160<sup>th</sup> Street and N 165<sup>th</sup> Street begins this week and will require closing the two-way left turn lane. Left- and U-turns will be possible at N 160<sup>th</sup>, N 163<sup>rd</sup> and N 165<sup>th</sup> Streets, as well as at all signalized intersections unless otherwise signed.
- N 152<sup>nd</sup> Street is closed for construction. Closure is expected for approximately two weeks while the contractor rebuilds the road. N 152<sup>nd</sup> Street will be closed 24 hours a day, seven days a week during this period.

### Special notes to pay close attention to:

- Work may be delayed as all concrete and aggregate suppliers in King County are closed due to an operator strike. It is unclear at this time what this means in regard to potential delays to the project but the impacts will be monitored closely.
- Since removing utility poles is one of the last steps of construction, you will see poles in the middle of asphalt paving and located where sidewalks will eventually be. Once the poles are removed, the asphalt for the road will be patched and final sections of sidewalk will be poured.
