## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

August 28- September 1, 2006

Here is what you can expect on Aurora Avenue:

- Final road preparations along the east side of Aurora from N 145<sup>th</sup> Street to N 160<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Paving of asphalt on the east side of the Aurora centerline from N 145<sup>th</sup> Street to N 160<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Installation of curb and gutter and driveways along the east side of Aurora from N 155<sup>th</sup> Street to N 160<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Continued construction of the Interurban Trail bridge walls.
- Installation of irrigation along the west side of Aurora.
- N 152<sup>nd</sup> Street is closed for construction while the contractor rebuilds the road. N 152<sup>nd</sup> Street will be closed 24 hours a day, seven days a week during this period. The road is expected to be reopened to traffic at the end of the week.

### Special notes to pay close attention to:

- Work may be delayed as all concrete and aggregate suppliers in King County are closed due to an operator strike. It is unclear at this time what this means in regard to potential delays to the project but the impacts will be monitored closely.
- Striping of Aurora between N 145<sup>th</sup> Street and N 160<sup>th</sup> Street will occur the night of September 5. The striping will move northbound traffic to the east of the road and the center turn lane will be restricted in preparation for construction of the center median.
- Since removing utility poles is one of the last steps of construction, you will see poles in the middle of asphalt paving and located where sidewalks will eventually be. Once the poles are removed, the asphalt for the road will be patched and final sections of sidewalk will be poured.
