## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

September 18 - 22, 2006

Here is what you can expect on Aurora Avenue:

- Installation of curbs, gutters and driveways along the east side of Aurora Avenue south of the Aurora Bridge. Expect closure of the outside northbound lane of Aurora.
- Continued construction of the Interurban Trail bridge ramp walls.
- Excavation for the center median between N 160<sup>th</sup> and N 165<sup>th</sup> Streets. Expect inside lane closures on north and southbound Aurora Avenue.
- Temporary pavement striping of Aurora between N 145<sup>th</sup> and N 160<sup>th</sup> Streets during the night of Monday, September 18. The striping will move northbound traffic to the east side of the road and the center turn lane will be restricted in preparation for construction of the center median.

### Special notes:

- Crews will begin the final asphalt lift on Monday, September 25, continuing for the following three weeks. Asphalt paving is weather-sensitive and cannot usually be done during heavy, continuous rain, so there may be some interruptions depending on the weather. Crews are hoping to get in and out as quickly as possible with the minimum possible disruption to businesses. There will be intermittent closures of driveways during this process.
- Since removing utility poles is one of the last steps of construction, you will see poles in the middle of asphalt paving and located where sidewalks will eventually be. Once the poles are removed, the asphalt for the road will be patched and final sections of sidewalk will be poured.
