## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

September 25 - 29, 2006

Here is what you can expect on Aurora Avenue:

- Paving, paving and more paving which will often require two-lane closures on the side where work is being performed. Expect long delays and interrupted access to businesses. Crews will be doing prep work for paving early in the week. The base layer should go down on Wednesday, with the final asphalt overlay starting on Thursday. Crews will work continuously during the day on Aurora Avenue as long as it is not raining. Crews will pave side streets during rainy weather. The goal is to have all paving done by October 10.
- N 160<sup>th</sup> Street east of Aurora Avenue will be closed starting Tuesday, September 26, for approximately two weeks for extensive repairs.
- Continued construction of the Interurban Trail bridge ramp walls and deck framing on the N 155<sup>th</sup> Street bridge.
- Installation of the concrete facing on the retaining wall near Parkwood Plaza.

### Special notes:

- Since removing utility poles is one of the last steps of construction, you will see poles in the middle of asphalt paving and located where sidewalks will eventually be. Once the poles are removed, the asphalt for the road will be patched and final sections of sidewalk will be poured.
- Looking ahead, the plan is to install the top structure of the Aurora Avenue bridge by the end of October and the barrier structure for the N 155<sup>th</sup> Street bridge before Thanksgiving.
