What have we been doing since December 2006?

- Public scoping meetings and comments were collected and collated from the November thru January 16 scoping period (comments from the two open houses and written comments).
- Held ten Aurora Business and Community (ABC) Team meetings.
- Prepared and submitted environmental reports to the State for review.
- Reviewed and developed updates to the Implementation Strategies (formerly the 32 Points).
- Evaluated natural storm water systems and potential applications for this Project. We have developed a toolkit for consideration.
- Developed a staff draft recommended alternative based on scoping comments, input from property and business owners and the Aurora Business and Community Team, and from our analysis of the three alternatives.

What do we want you to do tonight?

We have three goals for your participation tonight:

- 1. We have developed a draft recommended alternative that staff believes balances the opportunities and challenges along the corridor. It has some flexible elements that will allow the project to move forward with manageable impacts, yet still meets the community goals for aesthetics and safety. We'd like your feedback on this proposed design alternative.
- 2. We have revised the 32 Points with significant input from the Aurora Business and Community Team and want your input on the proposed revisions. They are now called Implementation Strategies.
- 3. We have information on proposed natural stormwater system treatments. We'd like your comments on these also.
