To the Dayton Avenue N./N. 175th Street Improvement Project
Open House

322 N. 175th Street in Shoreline

The retaining wall that supports the roadway and walkway on the west side of Dayton Avenue N. just south of St. Luke Place is deteriorating and needs to be replaced. Children walk to and from school along Dayton Avenue where cars often drive at high speeds. The City will not only be replacing the retaining wall, but will be making changes to the Dayton/St. Luke intersection to improve safety.

By combining the safety improvements with the retaining wall replacement, the City will be able to save money on project costs. The Dayton Avenue N./N. 175th Street Improvement project (see map for project location) will replace the existing wall, construct new sidewalks from N. 172nd Street to St. Luke Place N. and reconfigure the intersection of Dayton Avenue N. and St. Luke Place N. to shorten the crossing and remove the "soft" right turn.

The City is in the design phase for this project and invites you to come to the open house to learn more about the project, see what improvements are proposed and discuss your concerns, suggestions and questions about the project. The open house will be held Thursday, Dec. 1, 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. in the Rainbow Room in the O'Brien Center at St. Luke Parish located at 322 N. 175th Street (see map on back).
