

## **CONSTRUCTION UPDATE**

## May 2006

Construction is moving right along and we are still on schedule for completion by the end of June. There will be many visible changes this month. Here's what to expect:

- Qwest and Seattle City Light will begin to remove their wiring.
- Signal poles at NE. 177<sup>th</sup> Street and NE 180<sup>th</sup> Street will be replaced.
- Pavement overlay of 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE between NE 172<sup>nd</sup> Street and 15<sup>th</sup> Place NE.
- Installation of landscaping.
- Decorative pavement at the intersections.
- Restoring private property that was disturbed during construction such as the areas abutting sidewalks.

The utility poles will be removed once all the overhead wires have been removed. Once the poles are removed, the remaining sidewalk will be poured.

This month, some concrete panels and curb/gutter will be replaced in response to the City's concern regarding quality of the work and conformance to the specifications. We apologize for the additional inconvenience and disruption.
